



## **Rules Governing Distribution of Prizes**

### **Qualifications For Winning Prizes**

(Includes Silver and Gold Grand Prizes and all level prizes)

- All participants must raise a minimum of \$50 to be eligible for incentive prizes.
- Accumulation of prizes is not permitted; however, a bowler may select a lower level prize in lieu of the prize they qualified for.
- One prize per bowler will be awarded for raising the required dollar amounts. Bowlers cannot combine pledges to secure a higher prize.
- One bowler can win both the Silver and Gold Grand Prizes.
- All money (flat pledge and pledge per pin donations) must be turned into the FRC Development Department by the individual, Team Captain or designee, on or before the deadline date (February 15, 2010).
- Money collected after the deadline (February 15, 2010) will not be applied toward the grand prize, but it should be forwarded to the FRC Development Department.

### **Silver Grand Prize**

One Silver Grand Prize will be awarded to the bowler collecting and turning in the largest amount of money on the day of the event. If you hope to win the Silver Grand Prize, we encourage you to raise your money through flat pledges because your sponsorship money can be brought to the event. The Silver Grand Prize will be awarded to the winner during the event at Waveland Bowling Lanes.

### **Gold Grand Prize**

One Gold Grand Prize will be awarded to the bowler collecting and turning in the largest amount of money collected from both flat and per pin pledges. **Money must be turned into the FRC Development Department on or before the deadline date (February 15, 2010) and must be the result of the individual bowler's pledge collections.** The Gold Grand Prize winner will be determined after February 15, 2010, and the Gold Grand Prize will either be sent to the winner's home or picked up at FRC.
