### Team Captain Responsibilities

**Right away, YOU  
will want to be sure to:**

**1. Recruit a team of five (5) bowlers (you + 4 others).**

- Gather yourself and four of your best friends from school or your neighborhood.
- Family Team- Mom, Dad and the children on a team together.
- Scouts Teams- Gather up your closest friends from your Boy or Girl Scouts troops.
- China alumni families- reunite with your adoption travel group.

**2. Distribute bowler information to each team member and collect bowling fees (\$15 per bowler).**

**3. Set your minimum team goal of \$750; \$150 individual goal.**

**4. Encourage your team members to actively secure pledges/sponsors and monitor their progress.**

**One week prior to  
the event:**

**1. Send your team Registration Form and team members' registration fees to FRC's Development Department by January 22, 2010. Lanes are reserved on a first come first served basis.**

**2. Remind team members of the location of the Bowl-A-Thon, date of event, and lane assignments.**

**3. Remind bowlers to arrive at Waveland Bowl one half hour before the start of the game to pick up shoes and bowling ball.**

**When you arrive at  
Waveland Bowl:**

**1. Check in at the Registration Table at 11:00 am and receive lane assignments, information envelope and bowler gifts.**

**2. Turn in any pledges already collected by your bowlers!**

**3. Organize your team on the assigned lane and distribute gifts and door prize tickets.**

**4. Encourage team members to walk around and bid on silent auction items.**

**5. Be prepared to start on time**

**6. HAVE FUN!**

**After the second  
game:**

**1. Record scores on Pledge Summary and Sponsor Envelopes. Record your bowlers' high game and high series scores.**

**2. Turn in one copy of each sponsor form, along with one copy of the Pledge Summary Sheet at the Check Out Desk. Retain pink copies for your records.**
